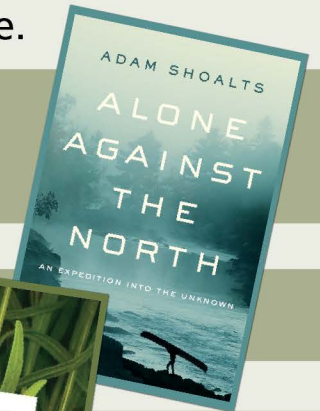
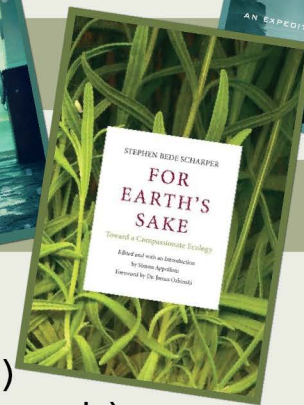
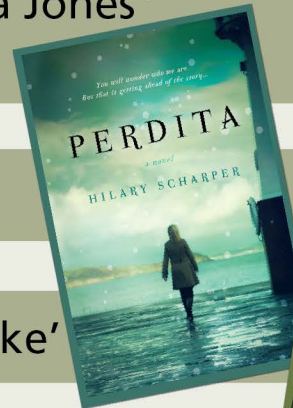
4:00 PM start - two authors before dinner, and one author after dinner, a time to purchase books and have these signed; silent auction and door prizes

Stephen Scharper - His most recent book, *For Earth's Sake:*



Toward a Compassionate Ecology', explores the notion of how we are being called to develop an affective relationship with the natural world in light of contemporary ecological challenges. His other books include *The Natural City: Re-envisioning Human Settlements* (co-editor, University of Toronto Press), *The Green Bible*, co-written with his spouse, Hilary Cunningham, and *Redeeming the Time: A Political Theology of the Environment* (Continuum). Dr. Stephen Scharper is associate professor at the School of the Environment and a Senior Fellow of Massey College.
